

CUB SCOUTS LEADERS UNIFORM

This is the uniform information guide for Pack 758 leaders. The information has been compiled and consolidated from many sources into this guide. The official uniform (Class "A") should be worn to all den and pack meetings and formal events.

All Cub Scouting leaders wear the same uniform with navy blue shoulder loops that indicate their program.

Trousers or Shorts

Official olive trousers or shorts with no cuffs.

(Switchbacks uniform pant converts into knee-length shorts with provided zip-off legs.)

Shirt

Official uniform tan shirt

(Long- or short-sleeve)

Socks

Official uniform olive color socks

Belt

Leaders can either wear

- Official uniform olive web belt
- Official uniform leather belt.



Cap (Optional)

- Can wear leaders cap
- Can wear the same visor cap as the youth they serve.

Neckerchief

- A Cub Scout leader navy blue neckerchief with gold Cub Scout emblem & edging may be worn with official Boys Scouts Slide by all Cub Scouts leaders.
- A Cub Scout leader bolo necktie can also be worn.



Activity T-Shirt:

The Pack 758 designates a special "Activity T-Shirt" to be worn for certain activities, such as sporting events or day camp.



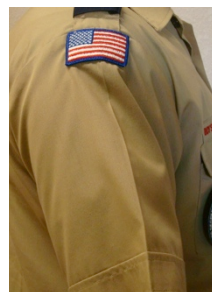
Official Placement of Insignia

Right Sleeve

Wear the U.S. flag (like Cubs Scouts wear)

Left Sleeve

- Wear the council shoulder emblem (Circle Ten)
- Wear the pack numeral as shown (Pack 758)
- Den leader or Asst. Den Leader Patch



Left Pocket

- The World Crest is worn centered between the left shoulder seam and the top of the left pocket.
- Wear medals 3/8 inch above the pocket seam and in the center. e.g: service stars
